Post Results Services

Following publication of results the exam boards offer a number of services if you have any queries. **These should only be requested following consultation with a Head of Department or a Subject Teacher.** The deadlines for some of these services are very tight and awarding bodies will not accept applications after these dates.

Student consent is required before a request can be processed, further information can be obtained from the Exams Office.
