Normally, we offer a range of trips and exchange visits, including to France and Germany. The college has strong partnerships with schools in Germany and France.</p> <p>All classrooms are equipped with computers and data projectors. In addition, we have a language laboratory, equipped with computerised work stations, Sanako software and internet access, as well as a dedicated language assistants' office and classroom. The Language Assistants hold conversation classes with small groups of pupils in separate classrooms. Alongside the curriculum the department runs an extra-curricular Japanese club for which the Japanese assistant would be responsible.</p> |
